



DRIVING TO UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND - EASTERN SHORE

From New York and points further north:

Take I-95 south to I-495 south via exit number 11 towards Port of Wilmington/Baltimore; I-495 south becomes I-95 south; merge onto DE-1 south via exit 4A towards Salisbury/Norfolk; follow US-13 south through Salisbury, MD to Princess Anne, MD; follow signs to MD Route 822 UMES Boulevard. Driving distance from Philadelphia to Princess Anne: 150 miles.

From Baltimore, Washington DC and Alexandria, VA:

Take appropriate route to Chesapeake Bay Bridge (eastern shore of Maryland); Route 50 east to Salisbury, Maryland; take Route 13 south to Princess Anne and follow signs to MD Route 822 UMES Boulevard. Driving distance from Baltimore, Washington DC and Alexandria to Princess Anne: 140 miles.

From North Carolina and points further south:

Take I-85 to Route 58 to route 17 (Norfolk) to Route 13 north; cross Chesapeake Bay Bridge and tunnel; follow signs to Maryland; pass through Pocomoke City to Princess Anne; follow signs to Somerset Avenue (MD-675); take a right onto Broad Street (second light in Princess Anne); cross railroad tracks to the south entrance of UMES. Driving distance from central North Carolina – 450 miles; from central South Carolina – 500 miles; from Atlanta – 700 miles.
